Leap Second Event

Issued Wednesday, 6 May 2015

Upcoming leap second event on June 30th, 2015 at 23:59:60 UTC.

Leap seconds are a periodic one-second adjustment of Coordinated Universal Time(UTC) in order to keep a system's time of day close to the mean solar time. However, the Earth's rotation speed varies in response to climatic and geological events, and due to this, UTC leap seconds are irregularly spaced and unpredictable.

The next leap second insertion is scheduled for June 30th, 2015 at 23:59:60 UTC.

Speakerbus have assessed their products in relation to this leap second event.

It is not expected that there will be any untoward effects of the leap second on Speakerbus products.
