Samba Vulnerability (CVE-2017-7494)

Speakerbus have been made aware of a vulnerability affecting the Samba package as shipped with iManager Communications Server (iCS).

This only affects the iCS product; all other products do not contain Samba.

Samba since version 3.5.0 is vulnerable to remote code execution vulnerability, allowing a malicious client to upload a shared library to a writable share, and then cause the server to load and execute it.

We are currently developing a new release of iCS updating to samba 4.4.4-14.

The new build version of iCS 2.5 is expected to be made available in August 2017.
